English Language & Cultural Learning Programme

The programme will provide opportunities for students to engage with the following activities:

- 16 hours of class based English language tuition and tutorials per week, over a three-week residential programme to include writing, reading, speaking and listening skills and support for students' academic research. This programme will improve your English and give you an insight into what is expected of you on a degree programme.
- A cultural programme of trips and visits across the North East region.
- First Rate Northumbria University student accommodation.

Programme Content

The information presented below is a potential outline of the three week English Language and Cultural Programme.

During the course of the programme, students will be given an introduction to the North East of England, 16 hours of English language tuition per week (including writing, speaking, reading and listening skills) personal tutorials and trips to places of cultural interest. There will be regular feedback and review, and the opportunity for the students to present their work at the end of the course.

English Language

It is expected that the students will have a reasonable level of English language proficiency in order to actively take part in all sessions using English at all times.

Accommodation

Accommodation will be within a ten minute walk of the city campus.
