

Fukushima Futaba Town Story Online Tour 1.27THU 18:00-20:00

On this online tour, we will introduce you to the current situation of Futaba Town, where the Fukushima Daiichi Nuclear Power Plant is located. Due to the nuclear accident and evacuation of the entire town in 2011, its approximately 7,000 residents are still unable to return to their hometown. On March 4th, 2020, the evacuation order was lifted in some areas of Futaba Town, finally allowing people to enter the town, but residents will not be able to live there until at least the spring of 2022.

In spite of these challenges, Futaba Town is not standing still! In addition to infrastructure development and housing construction, the feelings and actions of people from this area are moving forward by the day. Through this tour and opinion exchange, we want you to visit Futaba Town and see for yourself not only what has happened, but also what is happening now and what the town will become in the future.
